THE BIDDING PROCESS

You will receive your own bidding number on a bid paddle when you enter and register. Silent Auction items will be located in the in the Great Hall. *Bids for the silent auction close at 7:00, and then the live auction will begin at 7:15.*

To place a bid for the silent auction, write your bid number and name on the list that will be placed next to the item and write in the price you are offering. You may bid as many times as you like to bid higher than the last bid. When the bidding for the silent auction is closed, the person with the highest bid is awarded the item. The winning bid paddle number will be marked in front of each item.

The live auction begins in the Great Hall at 7:15. The order for bidding on items will be the order the items are listed in the catalog. To bid, raise your bid paddle and the auctioneer will recognize your bid. The winning bid and paddle number and amount will be recorded.

A 50/50 raffle with tickets for \$1.00 each or 6 for \$5.00 will also be held. Tickets will be sold all evening up through and even during the live auction. Fifty percent of the total collected will go to one lucky winner and the balance will go to the church. At the conclusion of the live auction a ticket will be drawn to determine the winner of half of the total cash. **You must be present to win the 50/50 raffle.**

Payment: There will be tables available in the lobby to pay for your purchase. Bring your paddle to the cashier area and an invoice will be created from your number with all of your items. Your paid receipt has contact information for hosts for all dinners, events and outings. The Auction Committee will notify the donors of the winning bidders and their contact information.

After you pay for your items (cash, check or credit card accepted) take your paid receipt back to the location of your item and Auction Volunteers will assist you in claiming your item. If your item includes is a gift certificate or gift card there will be a table in the back of the Great Hall where you can claim those items with your paid receipt.
