<p>Volunteer opportunities to serve the four stewardship sub committees. Campaign Communications (producing brochures, testimonial videos, etc.), Event Production (includes short-term task-oriented projects like mailings), Pledging Data Management (on-line database), and Visiting Stewards (meet with members and ask for their pledges)</p>	
<p>Committee meets monthly from January to May to build community through creative ideas, culminating in an annual fundraising auction. Lots of volunteers needed for the set up and take down and helping the night of the auction run smoothly.</p>	
<p>Volunteers participate in a major fundraiser for the church by working in our annual juried fine arts & crafts show for artists to exhibit and sell their work for several days in the fall. Over 200 volunteer positions available. Gallery at First UU is a great way to meet and work with other members of the church.</p>	
<p>Volunteers provide a variety of choral music for worship services 2 times a month. Weekly practice. No auditions necessary.</p>	
<p>Produces readers theater performances 2-3 times per year.</p>	
<p>Volunteers prepare and enjoy a simple supper at the church following vespers services each Wednesday evening at 6:00 pm</p>	
<p>Run sound board or project slides during weekly services. Training provided. Video recording to come.</p>	
<p>Volunteers work together to meet the needs of members and UU friends, such as providing meals or transportation. Birthday cards are sent to members age 65+</p>
